REGULATIONS ON THE SECTIONS OF YOUNG SCIENTISTS WITHIN REGIONAL BRANCHES OF INTERNATIONAL PUBLIC ASSOCIATION ACADEMY OF NAVIGATION AND MOTION CONTROL

The sections of young scientists are created within regional branches of the Academy according to the decision of Academy Presidium dated February 17, 2004. The purpose of these sections is to attract young researchers who have conducted successful studies in the field in navigation and motion control and authored scientific publications but still lack academic prestige required for the Academy full members.

The candidates should meet the following requirements:

- 1) Be up to 40 y.o.
- 2) Have an academic degree of candidate of sciences.
- 3) Author recent publications in the field of navigation and motion control.

Admission procedure

The young scientist wishing to join the Academy submits an application to the Academy President. The application differs from the standard one in that it reads "I wish to be admitted to the Academy (section of young scientists) within Academy <title> branch" instead of "I wish to be admitted to the Academy as a full member".

The candidate submits the Application and the filled in Information form to the Academy Branch. The Branch takes a decision to support the candidate and prepares a recommendation signed by the Branch Head

The Academy branch sends the Application, the Information form and the recommendation to the Academy Presidium.

At the Presidium session, the decision on admitting the candidate to the section of young scientists is taken. The Presidium informs the Branch Head and the candidate on its decision. The certificate and diploma of the member of section of young scientists are presented by the Presidium.

Presidium decision on admission to the section of young scientists is approved by the Academy General meeting.

Secession procedure

Once the member of section of young scientists within the Academy Branch reaches the limiting age (44 years), the Branch considers his secession from the section because of the limiting age and submits a proposal on secession to the Academy Presidium. If in the Branch's opinion the scientist meets the requirements to the candidates to the Academy full members, the Branch can recommend the Presidium to admit the scientist as an Academy full member, which should be reflected in the secession proposal.

The decision on the scientist secession from the section of young scientists because of the limiting age is taken by the Academy Presidium on the Branch recommendation. The Presidium decision on secession is approved by the Academy General meeting.
